There will be a 30 minute lunch break.

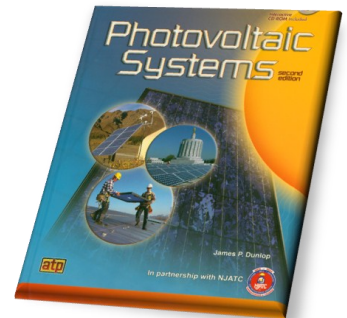
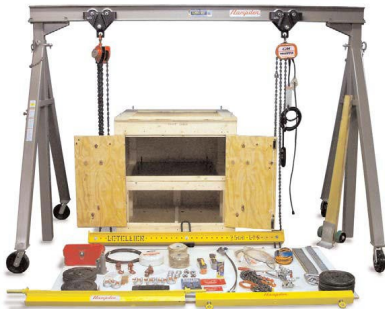
Course will be held at 810 Fremont Ave Local 415 Union Hall.

The first portion of our course covers the principles of photovoltaics and how to effectively incorporate PV systems into stand alone or interconnected electrical systems. The student will learn system advantages and disadvantages, site evaluation, component operation, system design and sizing, and installation requirements and recommended practices.

The remainder of the course will cover torque for terminations, rigging, and medium voltage terminations. The 34 hour course has been approved for **16 hours of code**.
